Remember – Items must be clean, dry and in no more than one tied carrier bag placed next to your bin.

SMALL ELECTRICALS One small carrier bag is collected weekly. Can also be recycled at community recycling centres.

Batteries in a separate bag

Remember – Items must fit into one small tied carrier bag that is placed next to your bin. Batteries can be put into a separate small bag.

FOOD BIN Collected weekly from your separate food waste bin.

Remember – You can line your caddy with carrier bags, vegetable bags or pedal bin liners. Please don't use black bin bags.
