

FUTURE CHANGES TO YOUR RECYCLING

Simpler Recycling plans are in the pipeline for Woking.

From 31 March 2026, you'll be able to add food and drink cartons (Tetra Paks) and empty aerosols to your dry mixed recycling bin. This is not yet in place. We will provide further communications as the date approaches, to help you prepare.

Meanwhile, please do not place these items in your recycling bin.

You can recycle cartons at your local community recycling centre (CRC). Alternatively, switch to refillable products instead of aerosols and swap products sold in cartons for those in recyclable packaging such as plastic, glass and metal - all of which can be recycled at home.
